A BOARD MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING OF USBC AND THE PORT HURON USBC ASSOCIATION AT THE TIME OF ELECTION AND THROUGHOUT THEIR TERM.

BE ABLE TO ATTEND MEETINGS AT LEAST QUARTERLY.

ENFORCE THE BY-LAWS.

COMPLY WITH THE USBC POLICY MANUAL.

ENSURE ADHERENCE TO ALL USBC PERFORMANCE STANDARDS.

CONDUCT CHAMPIONSHIP LEVEL COMPETITION FOR ITS MEMBERS.

PROVIDE EDUCATION, TRAINING, EVALUATIONS, RECOGNITION, AND OTHER SERVICES AS DETERMINED BY USBC.

IMPLEMENT USBC PROGRAMS.

SELECT/ APPOINT AND EVALUATE PERFORMANCE OF ASSOCIATION MANAGER.

CONDUCT SUSPENSION AND REINSTATEMENT HEARINGS.

MUST PASS BACKGROUND CHECK AS APPROVED BY USBC.

THERE ARE NO RESTRICTIONS TO ELECTIONS OR APPOINTMENTS WITH REGARD TO RACE, COLOR, RELIGION, GENDER, DISABILITY, NATIONAL ORIGIN, OR AGE OTHER THAN A MINIMUM OF 14.
